The Sunflower shade support it made of steel. The bench can be wood or metal with a plastic woven seat. This will be determined in maquette and pricing design phase. In or on the sides of the defined area, concrete spheres or limestone rocks in ascending size order, spaced child step distances apart, can be included as budget allows. This adds additional climbing components for children.

O'Michael's extensive public art making history, as well as the OMSI team, assure these will be made with appropriate engineering. This assures the safety of those using the area with protection North Richland Hills from potential liability.
